

Ribes viburnifolium

Evergreen Currant, Catalina Perfume



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Shrub
Height / Width:	3-6 ft. H x 12 ft. W
Plant Form:	Arching, trailing. Slow-growing.
Flower / Fruit:	Light pink to purplish, from midwinter into spring; red berries
Leaf:	Wine red stems with round 1- in. glossy, leathery green; fragrant after rain
Native To:	Catalina Island, Baja California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones:	5, 7-9, 14-17, 19-24
Soil:	Tolerant of moist soils, or dry conditions
Water:	Little to moderate
Sun:	Part shade to full shade
Care and Pruning:	Little care needed, prune in late winter or early spring to maintain desired shape/size.

Erosion control for banks, under native oaks, attractive to birds and butterflies
