PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Deciduous Shrub

Height/Width: 4-6 ft. H x 4-6 ft. H

Plant Form: Rounded with arching canes

Flower / Fruit: Pastel cloud of small pink flowers with lighter centers in large, loose clusters. Blooms hold up better in partial shade; spring to autumn

Leaf: Medium green

Native To: Hybrid, descendant of *R. moschata*

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 4-9, 12-24

Soil: Fertile, moist, well-drained

Water: Medium; Deeply and regularly with high temperatures.

Sun: Full sun or partial shade, Can tolerate more shade than most roses.

Care and Pruning: Prune lightly by up to one-third, reducing side shoots by one-half to one-third. To renovate, prune one in 4 or 5 shoots from the base.

Ideal for borders or hedges
Excellent companions to herbaceous perennials
