PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Shrubby Perennial
Height / Width:	3 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Multi-branched, upright
Flower / Fruit:	Light blue with whitish lower lip blooms mid-summer to frost if deadheaded regularly
Leaf Color, Size:	Strongly aromatic gray-green
Native To:	South Africa

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	14-17, 19-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Water well until established then low. Do not overwater.
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Cut back after flowering to keep it neat and vigorous
