PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Shrub
Height / Width:	2-4 ft. H x 4-6 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright
Flower / Fruit:	Red flowers much like <i>Salvia greggii</i> , very long bloom period
Leaf Color, Size:	Green
Native To:	Southeastern Arizona through southern Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	7-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun or partial shade (becomes rangy w/more water)
Care and Pruning:	Strong and robust. Prune out dead flower stems frequently. Remove dead wood, shorten and shape plants before spring growth. May reseed.
