<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>3 ft. H x 4 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Compact</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Magenta-pink to raspberry colored blooms May thru Nov</b>
<b>Leaf:</b>	<b>Medium green leaf with textured surface, bronzy winter tones</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Mexico</b>

## GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>7 - 24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Well-drained</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Low to moderate</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun or partial shade</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Prune out dead flower stems frequently. Remove dead wood, shorten and shape plants before spring growth.</b>
