PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Shrubby perennial
Height / Width:	1-3 ft. H x 1-3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright, branching
Flower / Fruit:	Spike-like clusters of ½-inch lavender flowers in late spring
Leaf:	Oblong, wrinkled, 2-3 in. long, gray-green above, white, hairy below, aromatic
Native To:	Mediterranean

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	2-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Drought-tolerant
Sun:	Full sun to part shade
Care and Pruning:	Delay pruning until new leaves begin to unfurl, cut just above fresh growth, avoid cutting into bare wood
