

# Salvia superba 'Rose Queen'

## Garden Sage



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Perennial
<b>Height / Width:</b>	2 ft. H x 2 ft. W
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Tight foliage rosette, spreads by rhizomes
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	1/4 to 1/2 in. rose colored flowers on 3-6 in. erect, branching stems; blooms summer thru fall
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	Wrinkled, dull green, finely toothed, oval or lance-shaped. Lower leaves 4-in.-long, upper ones smaller
<b>Native To:</b>	Hybrid of <i>S. nemorosa</i> and <i>S. sylvestris</i>

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	2-10, 14-24
<b>Soil:</b>	Well-drained
<b>Water:</b>	Low to regular
<b>Sun:</b>	Full sun, heat tolerant
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	Deadhead to encourage bloom Cut to basal growth in winter

**GARDEN USE** Perennial borders, cut flower gardens. Attracts hummingbirds
