PLANT DESCRIPTION

| Plant Type: | Perennial |
| Height / Width: | 2-3 ft H x 3 ft W |
| Plant Form: | Compact clump |
| Flower / Fruit: | 6-8 in.-long stems with $\frac{3}{4}$-in. indigo blue flowers with green bracts, in midspring to fall |
| Leaf Color, Size: | Medium green, scalloped, wrinkled, hairy, 3 in. long |
| Native To: | Garden hybrid |
