### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Evergreen shrub</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>2 ft. H x 3 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Rounded to cascading</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Bright yellow buttons in spring</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Aromatic, narrow green leaves like those of rosemary on brittle woody stems</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Mediterranean region</b>

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>3-9, 14-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Well-drained</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Little to moderate. Will rot out quickly with too much water.</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun</b>
<b>Care / Pruning:</b>	<b>Cut back yearly after bloom</b>
