#### **PLANT DESCRIPTION**

**Plant Type:** Herbaceous Perennial

**Height / Width:** 3 ft. H x 2 ft. W

**Plant Form:** Narrow yellow streamers arch outward and downward like vapor trails of a skyrocket

**Flower / Fruit:** Large branching clusters of small bright yellow flowers mid-summer to fall

**Leaf:** Narrow, linear to lance-shaped

**Native To:** Eastern U.S.

#### **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

**Sunset Zones:** 1-11, 14-23

**Soil:** Well-drained, not too rich

**Water:** Moderate

**Sun:** Full sun to light shade

**Care and Pruning:** Cut to ground in fall to promote new growth

Summer and fall garden color, informal borders, meadows. Pollen is not a problem.
