

Spiraea japonica 'Crispa'

Crisp Leaf Spirea



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Deciduous Shrub

Height/Width: 3 ft. H x 3 ft. W

Plant Form: Upright, shrubby

Flower / Fruit: Deep pink flowers in flattened clusters (3-in. across) in summer

Leaf: Dark green, twisted, crinkled with yellow-green variegation. Foliage emerges with a reddish tint.

Native To: Japan, China

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 2-10, 14-21

Soil: Average, medium, well-drained. Tolerates a wide range of soils.

Water: Regular to moderate

Sun: Full sun or light shade

Care and Pruning: Tough, easy-to-grow plant. Flowers on new wood; prune in late winter to early spring as needed.

GARDEN USE Specimen or foundation plantings. Mass or group in shrub border. Low hedge for paths & walkways. Group for rock gardens.
