

Tanacetum vulgare Tansy



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	3 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Coarse, weedy
Flower / Fruit:	Small, buttonlike yellow flowers appear in late summer
Leaf Color, Size:	Finely divided, fern-like, bright green, 6-8 in. long, aromatic
Native To:	Europe

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Not fussy
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun, afternoon shade in hot summer climates
Care and Pruning:	Thin clumps as needed to keep inbounds. Shear off spent flowers immediately to control any unwanted self-seeding.
