

Verbena lasioostachys

Western Vervain



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	2-3 ft. H x 2-3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Erect or diffusely branched and spreading
Flower / Fruit:	Covered with small blue verbena flowers all summer
Leaf Color, Size:	Broadly ovate or oblong-ovate 1-4 in. long, coarsely serrate
Native To:	California to Oregon

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

USDA Zones:	4-10
Soil:	Tolerates sand, clay, and no drainage
Water:	Low to moderate. Tolerates seasonal flooding
Sun:	Full sun
Care / Pruning:	Be aware: aggressive growth and reseeding

GARDEN USE

Consider when hydroseeding or planting for erosion control. Tolerates deer.
