PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1-2 ft. H x spreading
Plant Form:	Upright, spreading habit
Flower / Fruit:	Purple flowers in cylindrical clusters on stiff stems; blooms summer and fall, if deadheaded
Leaf:	Rough, strongly toothed, dark green, to 2-4 in. long
Native To:	South America

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones:	3-24
Soil:	Well drained soil
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Shear with weedeater after bloom to encourage rebloom. Cut back again in late fall.
