

Veronica 'Goodness Grows' Speedwell



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Perennial

Height/Width: 12 in. H x 12 in. W

Plant Form: Mat forming, neat tidy plants

Flower / Fruit: Spikes of beautiful violet-blue blossoms from late spring to frost

Leaf: Lance-shaped to linear, hairy

Native To: Most likely hybrid of *V. alpina* 'Alba' and *V. spicata*. Discovered as a seedling growing in Goodness Grows Nursery in Lexington, GA

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 1-7, 14-17

Soil: Any well-drained soil

Water: Regular

Sun: Full sun to partial shade

Care and Pruning: Deadhead to promote a long bloom season. Cut back plants to basal foliage around mid-autumn.

GARDEN USE Great for border fronts, rock gardens and as small area ground cover. Excellent container plant.
