Coast Rosemary



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen Shrub
Height / Width:	3-6 ft. H x 5-10 ft. W
Plant Form:	Dense and symmetrical
Flower / Fruit:	Small white flowers bloom along the branches year-round
Leaf Color, Size:	Linear dark gray-green leaves look similar to rosemary foliage
Native To:	Australia

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	8, 9, 14-24
Soil:	Light, well-drained, tolerates poor rocky soil
Water:	Little to moderate, drought tolerant
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Requires little maintenance

GARDEN USE

Can be grown as a dense rounded shrub or be sheared for a more formal look. Coastal areas, windy hillsides, and dry light shade under oaks
