PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Evergreen perennial
Height / Width:	2.5 ft. H x 5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Stiff, stemless clumps Slow to moderate growth rate
Flower / Fruit:	Tall spikes (4-7 ft. high) carry dangling clusters of creamy- white flowers in summer
Leaf:	Sword-like green leaves
Native To:	Southeastern United States

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Not particular, well-drained; tolerates sandy, rocky, average, poor and dry soils
Water:	Low to moderate
Sun:	Full sun
Care / Pruning:	Remove damaged leaves as necessary. Prune to control growth and shape.

GARDEN USE **Dramatic, showy; awesome display in large container pots. Adds architectural element to border.**
