## Strawberry Tree



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Evergreen Tree
<b>Height / Width:</b>	25 ft. H x 25 ft. W
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Rounded head
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	Clusters of small white, urn-shaped flowers in fall, warty strawberry-like red to yellow edible fruits the following fall
<b>Leaf:</b>	Oval, shallowly toothed, glossy, dark-green with red stems
<b>Native To:</b>	Southeast Europe, Ireland

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	4-24
<b>Soil:</b>	Fertile, humus-rich, well-drained
<b>Water:</b>	Tolerant to most watering
<b>Sun:</b>	Sun or partial shade
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	Can be pruned, not sheared, to make open-crowned tree

**GARDEN USE** Red-brown shredding bark and red fruits make it a very special ornamental tree

**BOTANICAL GARDEN** Butterfly Garden
