Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	2-4 ft. H x 2 ft. W
Plant Form:	Upright
Flower / Fruit:	Gold-centered, 2-4-in.-wide white flowers bloom in late spring - summer
Leaf Color, Size:	Coarse, leathery
Native To:	Europe

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Well-drained, improved with organic matter
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun, partial shade in hot summer climates
Care and Pruning:	Divide established clumps every 2 or 3 years in fall or early spring. Control snails and slugs.
