PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Perennial

Height / Width: 2.5 ft. H x 2 ft. W

Plant Form: Upright, vigorous, bushy

Flower / Fruit: Large (to 2-in.) fuchsia pink flowers in loose spikes at stem ends. Blooms mid-spring to fall.

Leaf: Narrow green

Native To: *P. campanulatus* parentage - origin Mexico and Guatemala

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: Perennial Zones 6-9, 14-24

Soil: Not too-rich, fast drainage

Water: Moderate

Sun: Partial shade in hottest areas

Care and Pruning: Trim after first bloom to encourage repeat bloom. Prune in late winter.

GARDEN USE Mass in borders or group with other summer-flowering plants. Attractive to hummingbirds & butterflies.
