Gloriosa Daisy Black-eyed Susan



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Herbaceous Perennial
Height / Width:	3 ft. H x 2 ft. W initially, then spreads by rhizomes to form larger clump
Plant Form:	Upright, branching
Flower / Fruit:	Yellow 2½ in.-wide, black to brown central cone in summer
Leaf Color, Size:	Broadly lance-shaped, 5-in.-long, hairy dark green
Native To:	Eastern U.S.

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Well-drained
Water:	Moderate to regular
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Cutting encourages rebloom. Divide every few years. Reseeds freely.

GARDEN USE	Tough and easy to grow. Showy blooms brighten summer and fall borders.
