

Agave americana 'Variegata' Variegated Century Plant



PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Succulent Perennial
Height / Width:	3-4 ft. H x 3-4 ft. W
Plant Form:	Large and imposing
Flower / Fruit:	After 8-10 years, produces branched, 2 ft. - 3 ft. tall flower stalk with yellowish green flowers
Leaf Color, Size:	Broad, pointed, variegated gray-blue leaves with yellow stripes taper to a sharp spine
Native To:	Southwest U.S., Mexico

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones:	10, 12-24
Soil:	Fast draining, sandy, gravelly
Water:	Drought tolerant
Sun:	Full sun to partial shade
Care and Pruning:	Allow plenty of room away from foot traffic
