## PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Perennial from bulb</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>6-12 in. H x 6-9 in. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Upright clump</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Nearly white, held high above foliage, blooming from April to May</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Grass-like, green, aromatic, hairy underside, from October to June</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Mediterranean region</b>

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>1-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Well drained soil</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Ample in summer</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun to full shade</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Can be invasive</b>
