

# Aloe striatula

## Hardy Aloe



### PLANT DESCRIPTION

<b>Plant Type:</b>	Succulent Shrub
<b>Height / Width:</b>	5-6 ft. H x 15 ft. W
<b>Plant Form:</b>	Scrambling, dense mound
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	Single spikes of yellow bells, flushed w/orange rise 6-18" above foliage in late summer
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	Dark green, 1" wide; distinctly striped leaf bases surround the stem; minute dull teeth. Larger stems tend to arch outward with age
<b>Native To:</b>	South Africa

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	8, 9, 12-24
<b>Soil:</b>	Excellent drainage, rich
<b>Water:</b>	Little to moderate
<b>Sun:</b>	Full sun to partial shade (Light shade in hot regions)
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	Easy, requires little care <b>SAP BENEATH THE SKIN IS AN IRRITANT</b>
