

# **Aquilegia chrysantha 'Yellow Queen' Golden Columbine**



## **PLANT DESCRIPTION**

**Plant Type:** Herbaceous Perennial

**Height / Width:** 1.5-3 ft. H x 1-2 ft. W

**Plant Form:** Erect clumps, spreading

**Flower / Fruit:** Large, upward facing, fragrant, bright yellow flowers with long, outward curving spurs

**Leaf Color, Size:** Lacy, green-gray, with finely toothed edges

**Native To:** Arizona, New Mexico, Mexico

## **GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

**Sunset Zones:** 1-24

**Soil:** Well-drained, average fertility

**Water:** Best with regular water

**Sun:** Light shade to shade

**Care and Pruning:** After bloom, cut back old stems for 2nd flowering, replace every 3-4 years. Reseeds.

Whimsical, fairylike, woodland-glen quality. Attracts hummingbirds
