PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type: Evergreen Shrub

Height/Width: 5-6 ft. H x 5-6 ft. W

Plant Form: Upright shrub

Flower / Fruit: Pink flowers in hanging clusters

Leaf: Gray-green leaves, purplish-brown bark

Native To: Species native to Sonoma area, California

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Sunset Zones: 4-9, 14-17

Soil: Heavy clay soils or serpentine, also does fine in loam or even granite

Water: Little to moderate; good tolerance for garden watering

Sun: Full sun or light shade

Care/Pruning: Prune as needed for structure

A show stopper against a dark background. Great for sunny areas where it endures heat and drought. Attracts hummingbirds, berries attract birds
