<b>Plant Type:</b>	<b>Woody Perennial</b>
<b>Height / Width:</b>	<b>3 ft. H x 3 ft. W</b>
<b>Plant Form:</b>	<b>Erect</b>
<b>Flower / Fruit:</b>	<b>Yellowish white flower heads in late summer</b>
<b>Leaf Color, Size:</b>	<b>Beautiful, feathery, lemon-scented gray-green foliage</b>
<b>Native To:</b>	<b>Southern Europe</b>

### GROWING REQUIREMENTS

<b>Sunset Zones:</b>	<b>2b-24</b>
<b>Soil:</b>	<b>Well drained, fertile soil</b>
<b>Water:</b>	<b>Little to moderate</b>
<b>Sun:</b>	<b>Full sun</b>
<b>Care and Pruning:</b>	<b>Cut back leggy growth before first flush of spring growth</b>
