Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1.5-2 ft. H x 3 ft. W
Plant Form:	Low, bushy, free flowering
Flower / Fruit:	Brilliant purple blooms from late summer to mid fall
Leaf Color, Size:	Dark green
Native To:	Vermont to Alabama, west to N. Dakota, Wyoming and New Mexico

Sunset Zones:	1-24
Soil:	Average, well-drained
Water:	Regular
Sun:	Full sun
Care and Pruning:	Pinch back best display. Pinch until July 4th-not after!
