**PLANT DESCRIPTION**

**Plant Type:** Perennial

**Height / Width:** To 4 ft. H x 3 ft. W

**Plant Form:** Upright

**Flower / Fruit:** Full clusters of bright mauve-violet flowers. Blooms around Sept 29<sup>th</sup> (St. Michael's Day)

**Leaf:** Dark green, smooth

**Native To:** Eastern North America

**GROWING REQUIREMENTS**

**Sunset Zones:** 1-24

**Soil:** Growth is luxuriant in fertile soil

**Water:** Regular

**Sun:** Full sun or partial shade

**Care and Pruning:** Pinch in spring to keep compact, pinching later will compromise the quantity of flowers. May be cut to the ground after blooming.

**GARDEN USE**

Abundant color in large borders or among shrubs. Large sprays effective in arrangements
